She is also a Master Environmental Consultant and a Gardening Consultant for NGC. Currently a Member of Crabapple and Stonehenge Garden Clubs, Creative Arrangers of the Americas, The Designer's Club of Georgia and the National Flower Arranger Guild. Lynn is a retired nurse from Columbus Children's Hospital and is active in numerous community activities, including author of "Merry Christmas from My House to Yours"; a small booklet on Using Natural Materials for Holiday Designs.

Heidi Muschick: Horticulture

General Information

Flower Show School, Course III, is the third in a series of four courses. NGC recommends that a course series be taken in sequential order, but this is not required.

Attendance is open to all garden club members and guests. To receive credit toward becoming an Accredited NGC Flower Show Judge, one must attend the Flower Show Procedure Zoom class and take the FSP exam as well as attend the full two-day course at the cost of \$180, pass the written exams, be an active NGC garden club member, and have the current updated NGC Handbook. The exam is optional for those who are attending for enrichment only.

Front seats will be reserved for students taking the course for credit. Those seats will be numbered and assigned in the order in which paid registration is received. Students must have their attendance verified daily and may not leave until the conclusion of the class to receive full credit.

Students should bring a clipboard, pencil and handbook downloaded from the NGC website, including all updates. Outlines will be emailed upon paid registration to students and attendees. Hard copies may be requested at a cost of \$10 (see registration).
